



Mount Olive Christian Early Childhood Center 2018- 2019 Class Offerings

Mount Olive provides age-appropriate learning experiences in a Christ-centered environment

Junior Kindergarten

**Class size will be limited to 18 students.*

This class is designed for children who are old enough for Kindergarten but parents feel they are not yet ready for the Kindergarten experience or have an early fall birthday. The day will be organized much like a preschool day with more structured activities to prepare the child for Kindergarten. Children in the class will also be taught some Spanish. **We will accept children who turn 5 up through October 31.** This class meets three days per week from 9:15 AM-2:45 PM. †

4-5 Year Old Classes

**Class size will be limited to 18 students.*

Extended Day † *(offered 2 or 3 days per week)*

Must be 4 by Sept. 1 of school year

This class is specially designed to give students a more relaxed opportunity for learning through the day. They are encouraged to expand their learning through hands-on, developmentally appropriate experiences. Children have more opportunity to immerse themselves in the theme being studied. "Quiet reading" time will be scheduled as part of the schedule after lunch to provide a rest time for those who still need it. It meets from 9:15 AM-2:45 PM.

Half-Day with Full Day option † *(offered 2 or 3 days per week)*

Must be 4 by Sept. 1 of school year

Parents may sign their child up for the half-day option or the extended day option. Those choosing the half-day option would go home at 11:45 AM and those choosing the extended day option would leave at 2:45 PM. As the year progresses and a parent decides their child might be ready for the extended day experience, they may choose to add the rest of the day. Experiences are provided that meet children's needs and stimulate learning in all developmental areas. Weekly themes are followed with a balance of structured and unstructured learning experiences.

Books are Fun †

Must be 4 by Sept. 1 of school year

This class is a literature-based class using books as the theme for the week focusing on print awareness and involving the children in telling and acting out stories. All projects and activities center around our books including weekly cooking projects. Experiences are provided that meet children's needs and stimulate learning in all developmental areas. Classes do journals and other enrichment activities in addition to traditional preschool activities. This class meets two days per week. It may be taken alone but many add it on to any 4-5 year old class creating a 4 or 5 day class. This class meets from 9:15 AM to 2:45 PM

3-4 Year Old Classes

**Class size will be limited to 14 students.*

Half-Day

Must be 3 by Sept. 1 of school year and toilet trained

Children's learning happens through their play and exploration at intentional learning centers set up throughout the room. Activities are designed to help strengthen small and large motor skills. Class meets two days a week from 9:15-11:45 AM.

Extended Day †

Must be 3 by Sept. 1 of school year and toilet trained

Children's learning happens through their play and exploration at intentional learning centers set up throughout the room. Activities are designed to help strengthen small and large motor skills. Nap/rest time will be scheduled after lunch followed by additional center time. Class meets two days per week from 9:15 AM until 2:45 PM.

Young 3's / 2-Year Old Classes

Young 3's Class *(For children who turn 3 after Sept. 1 of said year through Jan. 1, of the following year; children DO need to be toilet-trained by the start of the class.)*

Children's learning happens through their play and exploration at intentional learning centers set up throughout the room. Activities are designed to help strengthen small and large motor skills. The class will begin the first week of January meeting one day per week from 9:15-11:45 AM.

**Class size is limited to 14 students.*

Parent and 2's *(Children need to be 24 months of age by the start of the class and DO NOT need to be toilet-trained.)*

We will have two sessions (fall, spring), one day per week from 9:30-11:30AM. Activities would be tailor-made for 2 year olds. Parents would participate in interactive activities with their child individually and in group activities. Opportunities for parents to discuss issues pertaining to those terrific two year olds will include toilet-training, exploration play, power struggles, positive discipline, and developmentally appropriate activities.

**Class size limited to 10 students.*

Discovery Club

(before and after school care)

New this year! Before and After School Care. Expand your day with Discovery club! This will be led by our qualified childcare staff. Includes projects (art, cooking, science), indoor and outdoor physical activities, snack and quiet time (reading and educational videos). Additional \$15 non-refundable registration fee required.

Discovery Club is available before school from **7:30am – 9:15am** and after school from **2:45pm- 5:30pm**

† All-day students will bring a lunch from home and the school will provide the milk. Should classes fill quickly, Mount Olive is prepared to add additional classes.

- A \$35 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration for Parent and 2's
- A \$50 non-refundable registration fee is due at the time of registration for Preschool.
- A \$15 registration fee for additional family members, additional classes or Discovery Club added for same year
- There is a 10% tuition discount for additional students in the family.
- A 4% discount is given for tuition paid in full at the beginning of the year for classes that run 5 months or longer.
- Mount Olive members will receive a voucher booklet for discounted tuition.
- Tuition assistance available through Child Care Assistance Program (CCAP) for those who qualify
- Tuition scholarships available through Mount Olive Church for those in financial need.

Mount Olive reserves the right to cancel a class if enrollment is too small in any particular class. Families would be notified and every effort would be made to help them find an alternative class at our center. If no class would meet your needs, the registration fee and any prepaid tuition would be fully refunded.

Requests for admission to classes with age exceptions will be addressed individually.

Our programs are licensed by the State of Minnesota. All teachers are experienced and have a four-year degree and/or Early Childhood certification.
